**MEMORANDUM OF DECISION AND ORDER ON DEFENDANTS'
MOTION *IN LIMINE* TO EXCLUDE AND/OR LIMIT THE
TESTIMONY OF PLAINTIFFS' EXPERT, GEORGE DOUGLAS RICHMOND**

Before the Court for action at this time is Defendants' Motion *in Limine* to Exclude and/or Limit the Testimony of Plaintiffs' Expert, George Douglas Richmond (Docket No. 30). After full consideration of the written submission on said motion, and consideration of the record made for decision on said motion and of this Court's action on Docket No. 27 this date, the Court concludes that the motion should be granted and that the testimony of Mr. Richmond should be excluded from evidence at trial for the reason that the subject of his testimony is rendered irrelevant by the Court's decision, on Docket No. 27, to exclude from admission at trial evidence of Plaintiffs' "restoration costs."

Accordingly, the motion is hereby **GRANTED**. Defendants' request for oral argument is hereby **DENIED**.
