ORDER ON MOTION FOR TEMPORARY RESTRAINING ORDER

Before the Court is Plaintiff's Motion for Temporary Restraining Order (Docket # 21), the second such motion Plaintiff has filed. (See Docket # 3.) As explained herein, the Court DENIES the motion.

Again, Plaintiff's Motion fails to comply with the basic requirements for a temporary restraining order described in Federal Rule of Civil Procedure 65(b)(1), including the submission of an affidavit or verified complaint clearly showing immediate and irreparable injury, or a written certification explaining Plaintiff's entitlement to injunctive relief absent notice to Defendant. And even if the Court could overlook these procedural failings, the Court continues to believe that Plaintiff's filings do not support extraordinary injunctive relief, for reasons articulated in the Court's previous denial. (See Order (Docket # 5) at 1.)
