ORDER OF NOTICE

A review of the docket in this matter reveals that Michael L. Brewer, acting *pro se*, has filed at least six motions or memoranda in this multidistrict litigation since February, 2003. See Motion to Join and to Extend Time to File a Claim and/or Written Objection (Docket No. 245); Motion for Summary Judgment (Docket No. 250); Statement of Material Fact (Docket No. 261); Motion for Order/Modification Order (Docket No. 269); Nunc Pro Tunc Mem. (Docket No. 277); Motion for Order on “Motion for Modification Order” (Docket No. 276). I denied Mr. Brewer’s motions and noted that his pleadings did not comply with the Federal Rules of Civil Procedure or the Local Rules of this District and demonstrated no basis for the recovery sought. See Order (June 17, 2003) (Docket No. 271). In his most recent filing, Mr. Brewer objects to my denial of his motion for a modification order and moves for my recusal. See Objections to Order on Motion for Modification Order and Incorporated Motion to Recuse D. Brock Hornby Article III Judge (Docket No. 278). The objections and motion are frivolous and without merit and are therefore **DENIED**.

At this time, I place Mr. Brewer on **NOTICE** that filing restrictions “may be in the offing.” Cok v. Family Court of Rhode Island, 985 F.2d 32, 35 (1st Cir. 1993). This represents the “cautionary order” of which Cok speaks. Groundless and inappropriate filings will not be tolerated.
