ORDER MODIFYING PROCEDURES AND U.S. FISH AND WILDLIFE SERVICE COLLATERAL SCHEDULE FOR CERTAIN PETTY AND MISDEMEANOR OFFENSES

The order of this Court dated July 29, 2003, which established a plan whereby persons who committed certain minor offenses in violation of U.S. Fish and Wildlife Service statutes and regulations might dispose of such cases by forfeiture of collateral security furnished, is hereby VACATED.

It appearing that violations of Title 16 and Title 18, United States Code, do occur from time to time in various locations throughout the State of Maine, and within the jurisdiction of this Court, said violations generally being the misdemeanor offenses appearing on the attached *U.S.*Fish and Wildlife Service Collateral Schedule (Exhibit 1); and it further appearing that it would be for the benefit and convenience of all concerned that a plan be established whereby persons committing such misdemeanor offenses may dispose of said cases by payment of a fixed penalty, without the necessity of appearing before a United States Magistrate at Portland or Bangor, it is

ORDERED as follows:

- 1. The U.S. Fish and Wildlife Service Collateral Schedule, attached as Exhibit 1 to this Order, supersedes the collateral schedule attached to this Court's July 29, 2003 Order.
- 2. That any U.S. Fish and Wildlife Service Law Enforcement Officer, duly authorized to make arrests or issue violation notices for the misdemeanor offenses appearing on the

U.S. Fish and Wildlife Collateral Schedule, may issue a Violation Notice in the form provided by law.

- When Violation Notices are issued, a copy of the violation notice shall be forwarded within a reasonable amount of time to the Central Violations Bureau, Clerk,
 Administrative Office of the U.S. Courts – CVB (SA), P.O. Box 780549, San Antonio, TX 78278-0549.
- 4. All penalties remitted by offenders in accordance with this place shall be sent to:

Central Violations Bureau P.O. Box 780549 San Antonio, Texas 78278-0549

- 5. Whenever it is the opinion of the U.S. Fish and Wildlife Service Law Enforcement Officer or other official that the offense was of an aggravated nature, that person in their judgment, in lieu of issuing a Violation Notice, may bring the offender before the nearest United States Magistrate Judge, or order the offender to appear before such United States Magistrate Judge at a specified place and time.
- 6. This Order shall continue in effect pending further Order of this Court.
