Transmitting Documents for Filing in a Civil Action

Documents shall be filed by e-mail in PDF so that the documents can be added to the Court's Electronic Case Filing System (ECF) by the Clerk's Office. No individual PDF document shall exceed 20 MB in size. In the event that the number of email attachments exceeds 20 MB, consider sending the attachments over the course of several email messages in order to avoid a delivery failure.

The body of the e-mail must contain:

- The name of the filer;
- The address, e-mail address and telephone number of the registered pro se filer;
- The number of documents attached to the e-mail;
- The type of documents being filed including a brief description of documents attached;
- The title and docket number of the case.

Important: The body of the e-mail must not contain any other information. Only the documents attached to the e-mail will constitute your filing(s).
