

**Notice Regarding Discontinuance of the Use of the COVID-19  
Procedural Order Authorizing Foreclosure Plaintiffs To Seek a Default  
Judgment on Documentary Evidence**

In response to the COVID-19 Pandemic, the Court promulgated a “Foreclosure Procedural Order Authorizing Plaintiff To Seek a Default Judgment on Documentary Evidence” for use in foreclosure cases. More recently, the Court has resumed the scheduling of in-court hearings and, where authorized, has continued to conduct video hearings. See General Order 2021-2 (amended June 8, 2021); General Order 2021-4 (Mar. 12, 2021). Accordingly, the Court will discontinue the use of the Foreclosure Procedural Order effective July 14, 2021. Previously docketed Foreclosure Procedural Orders remain in full force and effect.
