Technical Instructions for Accessing the Court's Free Wireless Network

Those who wish to use this service must bring their own laptop computer or PDA with a built-in wireless network card or with an external wireless adapter that is 802.11a, 802.11b, 802.11g or 802.11n compatible. See Local Rule 83.8 for restrictions on the use of this electronic equipment in the courthouse. The following details the requirements necessary to access the wireless Internet:

- Users should be aware that there are security, privacy and confidentiality risks inherent in wireless communications and that the United States District Court does not make any assurances or warranties relating to such risks.
- The Court's wireless network is identified by the name "MED-Bar".
- When you connect to the wireless network you will be prompted for the password you were issued by the court. You are now connected!
