Dear Prospective Juror:

Your name has been randomly selected from a combined list of registered voters and driver's license holders to complete a questionnaire for potential federal jury service in the U.S. District Court for the District of Maine. Trial by jury is a cornerstone of the American justice system, and jury service is an opportunity to participate in your government as well as an obligation of every American citizen.

You are not being summoned to appear at this time, but the Court requires that you provide additional information to determine your qualification as a juror. Federal Law requires that you complete a Juror Qualification Questionnaire.

Do not call or send letters or emails asking to be excused. If you are summoned later, you will be given the opportunity to request to be excused at that time.

If you are over the age of 75 and would like to be excused from jury service, you may request excuse in section 14 of the questionnaire, Grounds for Requesting Excuse. No other grounds for excuse will be considered at this time.

You must complete and return this questionnaire, either through eJuror or by paper. If you lack access to a computer, please request a paper questionnaire by calling 1-833-902-4066 or 207-218-0404.

If you are unable to use the eJuror link, the Court will mail you a paper questionnaire.

If you have trouble logging into eJuror, please make sure that you are using the District of Maine's eJuror site by using the eJuror link found at www.med.uscourts.gov. Do not attempt to find eJuror using a search engine such as Google as it will likely take you to another Court's site and you will not be able to log in.
